DESCRIPTION

EPDM Quick Roof Flashing Tape is uncured EPDM rubber with specially formulated butyl mastic used in applications on roofs where pipes, stacks, vents, or corners require flexible flashing products to ensure no water infiltration into the roofing system. EPDM Quick Roof Flashing Tape allows molding or slight stretching of the material then slowly cures to form. With superior tack and peel strengths, our butyl mastic remains flexible in harsh conditions and gives a permanent water tight seal. Industry standard roofing membrane cleaners and primers must be used to clean the surfaces before application.

Always clean and prime membrane using roofing industry standard products for tape applications such as F-Primer or Low VOC Tape Primer. Allow primer to dry before installing tape. Field flashing corners, stacks, vents, or other roofing installation procedures where material must be formed. Do not over stretch. Not for use in horizontal seam repairs. Application by experienced roofing professionals recommended.

Resistant to: Weather, water & water vapor, (5%) acidic or basic solutions.

Effected by: Petroleum, grease, oil, solvents, vegetable oils, and animal fats.

Product Storage: Store in warehouse without excessive heat. Do NOT store long term on roof.

Shelf Life: 1 year if stored between 60° and 80° F.
